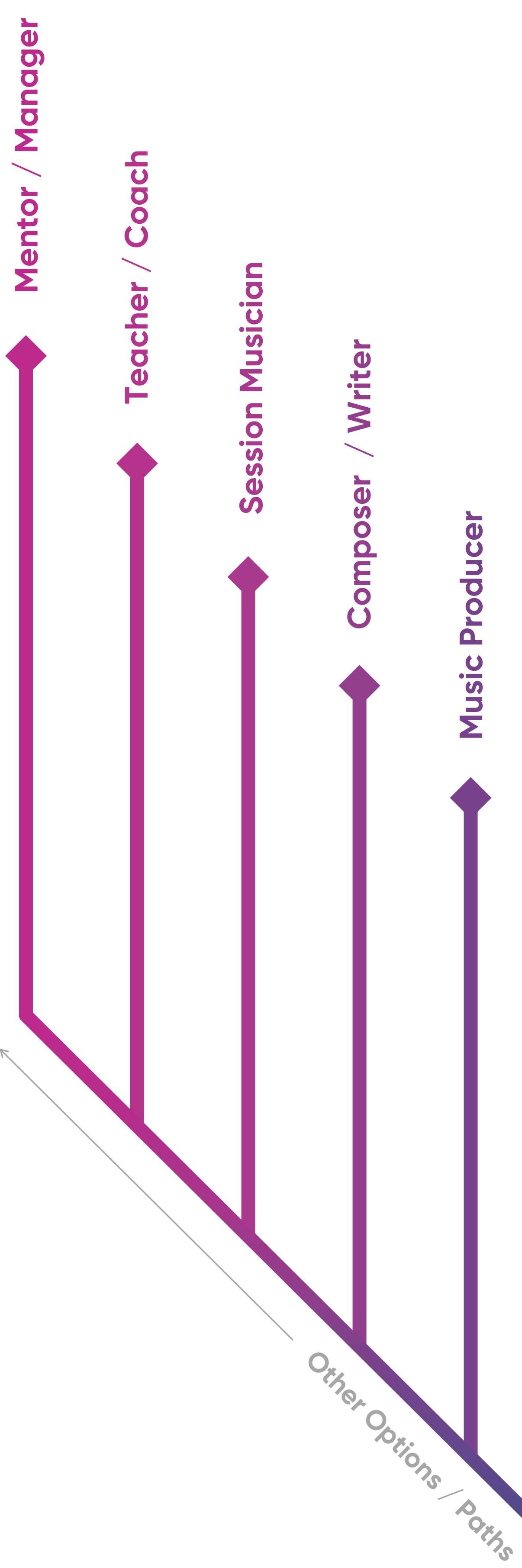
# Artists, Singers & Song Writers

Such an artist performs their roles of the composer, lyricist, vocalist, occasional instrumentalist, and often self-manager.
